Juliet, Naked is a film about a very unique love triangle. Annie (Rose Byrne) is stuck in a long-term relationship with Duncan (Chris O'Dowd), who is an obsessive fan of obscure rocker Tucker Crowe (Ethan Hawke). When the acoustic demo of Tucker's hit record from 25 years ago surfaces, its release leads to a life-changing encounter with the elusive rocker himself. Based on the novel by Nick Hornby, *Juliet, Naked* is a comic account of life's second chances.

This is the true story of Ron Stallworth, who, in the turbulent early 70s, was a rookie cop and the first African-American on the Colorado Springs Police Department. Determined to prove himself, Ron takes an undercover assignment, first with a local black activist group. He soon spots an ad seeking members to a new chapter of the KKK and calls the number. In an incredible truth-is-stranger-than-fiction story, with a fellow officer, he infiltrates white supremacists as the first "blacKkKlansman".
